Continue to develop and grow our ministry with River Kids.

Establish a New Members Evening once every term.

A:cting in Love

From the very beginning of River Community Church, we have placed a strong emphasis on being an outward looking church. This includes both **EVANGELISM** and **OUTREACH.** Many people are already involved in some vital ministries and we plan to continue to support these in the year ahead. Our support will be expressed through (1) getting involved (2) supporting financially and (3) regular prayer on Sundays and at Prayer Central. This year, our main priorities are:-

Recruit more volunteers for **Street Pastors** and **Prayer Pastors**.

Support and encourage the KIP Project.

Develop our outreach to pupils and staff in Lawley School.

Offer the ALPHA COURSE twice a year and keep it at the heart of church life.

Support and be actively involved in local **Community Events.**Continue the work of outreach in **LIGHTMOOR**.

Launch a ministry to **Men** with a regular activities programme.
